## **PRISONERS' WIVES' VISITS TO SWITZERLAND.**

### **SECOND PARTY ARRANGED.**

The second party of wives and relatives of interned British prisoners of war, who are being taken to Switzerland by the British Red Cross officials, will leave London next Saturday to visit the wounded men at Chateau d'Ex.

The party will number 18, and the arrangements for their journey, and their fortnight's stay in Switzerland, will be similar to those made for the first party, which left during the last week-end.

### **HULL FREE FROM PLAGUE.**

The Hull Corporation Health Committee yesterday received a report from the Medical Officer of Health that, after 10 days from the outbreak of bubonic plague, the port and city was declared free from this disease.
